Call Your Insurance Company

Once you are home from the hospital, it is VERY important that you call your insurance company and tell them the baby has been born. The insurance company will not pay for any services that the baby received in the hospital or afterwards if you do not call them to tell them he/she has been born and request that they be added to your policy.

Your Baby's Schedule for Doctor's Visits

There are several schedules for routine well baby visits. The schedule that Dawson Pediatrics recommends is given below.

(* Vaccine is given)

- At one week of Life
- 1 Month *
- 2 Months *
- 4 Months *
- 6 Months*
- 9 Months*
- 1 Year*
- 15 Months*
- 18 Months*
- 2 Years
- 3 Years
- 4 Years *
- Each Year after that throughout childhood.

We think the well-baby examination is an ideal time to discuss concerns or questions with the physicians. This may include special questions you have about immunizations, nutrition, growth and development, accident prevention and family related concerns. If you have important questions, it is a good idea to write them down before going for your well-baby visit- you will save time and won't forget any of the questions you wanted to discuss.
